

S.C. BASS Nation 6 Man Tournament Rules

1. Team captains must attend meeting on Thursday and answer for their team.
2. All waters designated as OFF LIMITS will be marked.
3. Boaters will start arriving at landing only one hour before designated unloading time. You may come by water.
4. Each boater will be given a card with their boat number. Both anglers are responsible for their boat number. Boat numbers will remain the same both days. Blast off order will be reversed for Day 2.
5. On Day 1 all 1st flight boats are to be at the ramp starting at 5:00 AM and weigh-in will be 3:00 P.M. On Day 2 you will be 3rd flight and are to be at the ramp starting at 6:30 AM and weigh-in will be 3:30 PM.
6. On Day 1 and Day 2 all 2nd flight boats are to be at the ramp at 5:45 AM and weigh-in will be 3:15 PM.
7. On Day 1 all 3rd flight boats are to be at the ramp at 6:30 AM and weigh-in will be 3:30 PM. On day 2 you will be 1st flight and are to be at the ramp starting at 5:00 AM and weigh-in will be at 3:00 PM.
8. Once boaters are in the water, do not tie off to any docks. Proceed to the staging area and await blast-off.
9. Anyone fishing with a Board of Directors member or District Rep will weigh-in at 2:45 PM both days.
10. All boats will be checked at blast-off for lights, life jackets, kill switches and aerators. Boats having mechanical problems will be sent to the staging area until repairs can be made.
11. Please stay behind blast-off boat and line up by boat number. All boats must be checked at blast-off.
12. Returning to weigh-in: All boats must check in. Even if you have no fish you must check in so we will know you are in safely. After checking in, load your boat and try to park back in the same parking space. No trailers will be allowed in weigh-in area. Bag your fish and proceed to weigh-in area
13. To fish SC BASS Nation tournaments, you must be in good standing with B.A.S.S. and be prepared to present a valid B.A.S.S. membership card if asked.
14. Penalties are the same as S.C. BASS Nation Rules. No use of alcohol or drugs including any prescription drugs that may impair your ability to operate a boat in a safe manner.
15. Anyone leaving the tournament (not having an alternate) will lose another member of his/her team.
16. Everyone is expected to conduct themselves in a safe and courteous manner and follow the rules at all times.
